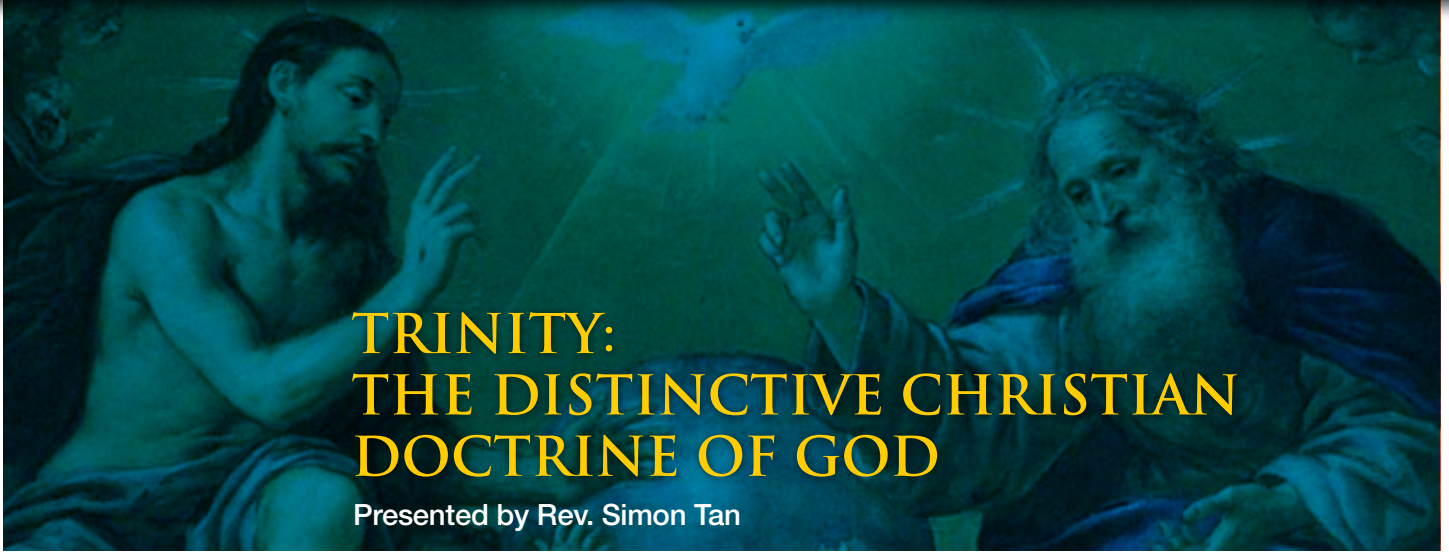

This unit outlines the biblical teaching on God as one and three and traces how the doctrine of the Trinity was formulated in subsequent history to ensure that fundamental biblical teaching is not eclipsed. Attention is also given to the rich discussion on the doctrine of the Trinity in the last forty years and to the practical outcomes that a right doctrine of God suggests.

ABOUT REV. SIMON TAN

Rev. Simon hails from Singapore and is a pastor of Trinity Christian Centre Singapore since 2000. He holds a Master of Arts in Biblical Studies—Far East Advance School of Theology (FEAST) Philippines, Master of Divinity—Theological Centre of Asia (TCA) Singapore, and Master of Theology—University of Notre Dame (UND) Australia.

He is an ordained minister of the Assemblies of God Singapore since 1989, and was a pastor of Calvary Charismatic Centre Singapore from 1982-2000. He was also its missions-pastor for 3 years and helped established Calvary Charismatic Centre Philippines in 1985, and Mauritius in 1988.

Rev. Simon has been lecturing Bible and Theology for over 21 years in many seminaries and churches, in Singapore and overseas. He was a resident faculty of Asia Theological Centre for Evangelism and Missions (ATCEM) between 1988-1999, and was its Academic Dean from 2000 – 2004. He is presently a doctoral (D. Min. program) candidate of the Asia Pacific Theological Seminary in Baguio, Philippines. He resides in Singapore with his wife Rapheal and daughter Caroline.

Dr. Roli earned his B.C.M., at Bethel Bible College, Manila, Philippines (1987), M.Div., Asia Pacific Theological Seminary, Baguio City, Philippines (1990), Th.M., Asia Baptist Graduate Theological Seminary, Baguio City, Philippines (1997), and Ph.D., University of Birmingham, UK (2005). Prior to joining the faculty of APTS in June 1991, Dr. Roli served as children's pastor and pioneering pastor of three local congregations. He is an ordained minister of the Philippines General Council of the Assemblies of God.

His current research interest is in the area of New Testament textual criticism, contextual biblical hermeneutics and Pentecostal theology and practices. Koine Greek, New Testament courses and interpretation of the Scriptures are the courses that Dr. Roli enjoys teaching. He has published a few journal articles and book reviews. He has also presented academic papers for seminars and lectureships.
